DECISIONS TAKEN IN THE 54TH MEETING OF THE NATIONAL DEVELOOPMENT COUNCIL HELD UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF THE PRIME MINISTER ON L19TH DECEMBER, 2007

The National Development Council met under the Chairmanship of the Prime Minister on 19th December, 2007 at Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi to consider and approve the draft Eleventh Five Year Plan (2007-12).

- 2. After deliberations and discussions, the following decisions were taken:
 - (i) The National Development Council endorsed the Eleventh Five Year Plan (2007-12);
 - (ii) Several specific points raised by Chief Ministers were responded to by the Prime Minister, Finance Minister and Deputy Chairman, Planning Commission. The other specific suggestions made by States/UTs. could be considered during the State Plan discussions;
 - (iii) A Task Force would be constituted in the Planning Commission to comprehensively examine the resource requirements for expanding irrigation and identifying a new approach to implementing irrigation projects. The Task Force would identify innovative ways of raising resources and designing and implementing projects so that we can rapidly achieve our irrigation potential;
 - (iv) The Finance Minister, in consultation with the Agriculture Minister, is finalizing a scheme for addressing the issue of the debt burden of farmers. The details of this would be announced shortly;
 - (v) A Task Force in the Planning Commission would be constituted to look into the problems of hill states and hill areas and inter-alia to suggest ways for addressing their specific connectivity, transport & infrastructure problems;
 - (vi) The Power Ministry would accelerate the sanctioning process under the RGGVY and the Planning Commission would make the resources available to meet the rural electrification targets.
 - (vii) The Finance Minister would constitute an Expert Group to go into the system of statutory clearances for industrial and infrastructure projects and suggest concrete ways to speed these up.
